## Intro to Sailing

A four-hour class introducing sailing concepts, including rigging and basic sailing techniques.

**Cost:** \$50

**Available in** January, February, March, July, August.

## Basic Sailing - Flying Scot (ASA101)

A two-weekend class to learn to sail and rent a Flying Scot. Some swimming required. Includes written exam for ASA101 certification. Swimming required.

**Cost:** \$350

**Available in** March, April, May, June, September, October, November, December.

## Basic Sailing - Catalina 22 (ASA101)

A two-day class to learn to sail and rent a Catalina 22. No swimming required. Includes written exam for ASA101 certification.

**Cost:** \$350

**Available in** January, February, November, December and by appointment.

## Coastal Navigation (ASA105)

A six-session class to learn safe navigation in coastal and inland waters. Written exam for ASA105 certification.

**Cost:** \$350

**Available in** June and December.

## Basic Celestial Navigation (ASA117)

A six-session class to learn to determine position using a sextant and nautical almanac. Written exam for ASA117 certification.

**Cost:** \$350

**Prerequisite:** ASA105 (Coastal Navigation)  
**Available in** February and August.

## Advanced Celestial Navigation (ASA107)

A six-session class to learn advanced celestial navigation techniques for offshore waters. Written exam for ASA107 certification.

**Cost:** \$350

**Prerequisite:** ASA117 (Basic Celestial Navigation)  
**Available in** April and October.

## ASA Challenges

Patrons with experience can challenge any ASA class and demonstrate skills for ASA certification.

**Cost:** 50% of the class cost

**Prerequisite:** Must have prior sailing experience and/or ASA certifications.

### Flying Scot

A 19-foot open sailboat, known for its stability and ease of handling. Ideal for those looking for a relaxed sailing experience.

### Catalina 22

A 22-foot day-sailer with an outboard motor. Its compact design offers a comfortable and enjoyable ride, whether for a day trip or just a fun outing with friends and family.

Boat eligibility is based on experience. Completing a Checkout Sail can expand your rental options.

## Additional Sailing Offers

### Checkout Sail

A 1-4 hour checkout with an instructor for rental authorization of the next boat class.

Cost: \$75

Prerequisite: ASA101 certification (or equivalent experience).

Available year-round by appointment.

### Supervised Sailing

Sailing under the supervision of an instructor, either on the boat or from a chase boat.

Cost: \$25

Prerequisite: Must have prior sailing experience and/or ASA certifications.

Available in April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December.

### Safe Boating Class

A six-hour classroom and on-water training required for obtaining the FWC Boater's Card, which is necessary for most boat rentals.

Cost: \$35

Available year-round by appointment.

### Private Lessons

Custom sailing instruction based on your schedule and goals.

Cost: Varies by class.

Prerequisite: Based on desired lesson and goals.

Available year-round by appointment.

### Educational Seminars (FREE)

Taught in the classroom and/or on the water.

Topics: Intro to Celestial Navigation, Anchoring, Charts, VHF Radio, Reefing, & Night Sailing.

Available every other month. Call the marina (904) 542-3260 for details.

### Dinner Cruises

Evening boating trip from Mulberry Cove Marina to a local restaurant, with transportation back to the marina.

Cost: \$35 per person, up to six people per boat.

Available in April, May, June, July, August, September.
